Volunteers make a tremendous impact on Redeemer by enriching the school program, reducing costs and building a strong sense of community between students, staff and parents/guardians. Please read the Service Points Record to see how it impacts you and use it to track your points so that you get appropriate credit at the end of the year.

On Registration Day, we will collect your “Volunteer Interest Sheet”.

Volunteer Service Points Goal per family is 750. Single parent family’s goal is 375 points. All volunteer service points count! If your family has achieved 750 points by June 30, 2011, your \$500 Volunteer Service Points cheque will be returned to you after June 30. If your family has achieved less than 750 Volunteer Service Points, you will receive credit for points achieved and will be asked to submit a new cheque to the school after June 30, 2011. Once received, your original \$500 cheque will be returned to you. If your “Service Point Record” is not returned we will cash your cheque.

It is important for all families to submit their “Service Point Record”.

Parents/guardians will be notified of opportunities to volunteer through the school newsletter (**The Redeemer Reminder**). As well, participating in class trips, driving to school sports and tournaments, and helping at school functions all qualify. See the “Volunteer Interest Sheet” for many opportunities there are to volunteer.

How Many Volunteer Hours do we Use to Make our School Run?

Let’s keep track of all of our volunteer hours!!

Even if you have completed your commitment and have 750 points, please continue to record your volunteer hours. It will help to know how much volunteer time is put into our school to keep it running. Also, it can be used as a guideline for planning activities and events in future years.

By June 30, 2011 families return a completed Service Point Record to the school.

Your \$500 cheque will be returned after June 30 if the requirements have been fulfilled and a Service Point Record has been submitted to the school.

How to Achieve Service Points?

Refer to the Membership Committee person(s) for membership in the Association: points obtained upon acceptance of membership application	300 points
